

# British Insects: the Plume moths (Pterophoridae and Alucitidae)



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## Conventional key

If you are serious about identification, you should use the [interactive key](#). It is far superior, with flexible choice of characters, character notes and illustrations, error tolerance, full taxon descriptions, and taxon illustrations.

- 1(0).
  - Forewings conspicuously patterned with contrasting bars or fasciae ... [2](#)
  - Forewings relatively plain or merely dotted... [12](#)
- 2([1](#)).
  - Hindwings with a large black scale-tooth in the dorsal cilia of the posterior segment ... [3](#)
  - Hindwings with two large subapical black scale-teeth conspicuous in the dorsal cilia of the posterior segment, these separated by a white one, and with white scales along the dorsum of the lobe ... *Capperia*
  - Hindwings without large black scale-teeth in the the posterior segment... [6](#)
- 3([2](#)).
  - The large scale-tooth in the posterior hindwing segment located in the middle of the dorsum ... *Platyptilia*
  - The large scale-tooth in the posterior hindwing segment located much beyond the middle of the dorsum... [4](#)
- 4([3](#)).
  - The base of the fissure preceded by a white fascia ... *Cnaemidophorus*
  - The base of the fissure preceded not associated with noticeable marking... [5](#)
- 5([4](#)).
  - Forewings cleft from about the middle; forewing vein 10 out of 8; labial palps ascending; adults not hibernating ... *Oxyptilus*
  - Forewings cleft from beyond the middle; forewing vein 10 separate; labial palps sub-ascending; adults (those of the second brood) hibernating ... *Amblyptilia*
- 6([2](#)).
  - Hindwings similarly coloured to the forewings ... [7](#)
  - Hindwings differently coloured from the forewings... [9](#)
- 7([6](#)).
  - Tibiae simple ... [8](#)
  - Tibiae thickened with scales at the origins of the spurs ... *Pselnophorus*
- 8([7](#)).
  - Forewings cleft from about the middle; the lower lobe tapering distally or more or less parallel-sided; face smooth (neither tufted nor with a horny prominence); forewing venation exhibiting the cell produced into points; forewing vein 3 absent ... *Pterophorus*
  - Forewings cleft from beyond the middle; the lower lobe expanded towards the apex; face with a horny prominence; forewing venation exhibiting the cell apically truncated; forewing vein 3 present ... *Stenoptilia*
- 9([6](#)).
  - Forewings 2-segmented; hindwings 3-segmented ... [10](#)
  - Forewings 6-segmented; hindwings 6-segmented ... *Alucita*
- 10([9](#)).
  - Forewings cleft from before the middle ... *Buckleria*
  - Forewings cleft from about the middle... [11](#)
  - Forewings cleft from beyond the middle ... *Oidaematophorus*
- 11([10](#)).
  - The lower lobe tapering distally or more or less parallel-sided; face smooth (neither tufted nor with a horny prominence); forewing venation exhibiting the cell produced into points; forewing vein 3 absent; the second hindwing lobe 2-veined veins ... *Pterophorus*

- The lower lobe expanded towards the apex; face tufted; forewing venation exhibiting the cell apically truncated; forewing vein 3 present; the second hindwing lobe 3-veined ... ***Marasmarcha***

12(1). • Forewings entire; hindwings entire ... ***Agdistis***  
 • Forewings conspicuously cleft; hindwings conspicuously cleft... [13](#)

13(12). • Hindwings similarly coloured to the forewings ... [14](#)  
 • Hindwings differently coloured from the forewings... [15](#)

14(13). • Forewings cleft from about the middle; the lower lobe tapering distally or more or less parallel-sided; face smooth (neither tufted nor with a horny prominence); forewing venation exhibiting the cell produced into points; forewing vein 3 absent ... ***Pterophorus***  
 • Forewings cleft from beyond the middle; the lower lobe expanded towards the apex; face with a horny prominence; forewing venation exhibiting the cell apically truncated; forewing vein 3 present ... ***Stenoptilia***

15(13). • Hindwings with a large black scale-tooth in the dorsal cilia of the posterior segment; forewing venation exhibiting the cell apically truncated; forewing vein 9 present; the second hindwing lobe 3-veined ... ***Oxyptilus***  
 • Hindwings without large black scale-teeth in the the posterior segment; forewing venation exhibiting the cell produced into points; forewing vein 9 absent; the second hindwing lobe 2-veined veins... [16](#)

16(15). • Forewings cleft from about the middle ... [17](#)  
 • Forewings cleft from beyond the middle... [19](#)

17(16). • Forewing vein 3 present; forewing vein 8 present; labial palps ascending; feeding concealed ... ***Adaina***  
 • Forewing vein 3 absent; forewing vein 8 absent; labial palps sub-ascending; feeding exposed... [18](#)

18(17). • The lower lobe tapering distally or more or less parallel-sided; forewing vein 10 present ... ***Pterophorus***  
 • The lower lobe expanded towards the apex; forewing vein 10 absent ... ***Merrifieldia***

19(16). • Forewings with 2-3 small dark dots on the posterior margins of the lobes near their apices ... [20](#)  
 • Forewings without posterior marginal dark dots ... ***Hellinsia***

20(19). • Wing-span up to 20 mm ... [21](#)  
 • Wing-span 20 to 24 mm ... ***Euleioptilus***  
 • Wing-span 25 to 32 mm ... ***Emmelina***

21(20). • Forewings with a blackish costal dot towards the apex ... ***Ovendenia***  
 • Forewings without a blackish costal dot towards the apex ... ***Euleioptilus***
